WE ARE

The European External Action Service (EEAS) is the European Union's diplomatic service. Since 2011, the EEAS carries out the EU's Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) to promote peace, prosperity, security, and the interests of the EU across the globe. It brings together European civil servants, diplomats from EU Member States, national experts and local staff worldwide.

The EEAS supports the High Representative in the exercise of her mandate to steer the Union's CFSP, including the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP), to represent the EU on issues relating to the CFSP and to chair the Foreign Affairs Council. It also supports her as Vice-President of the Commission with regard to her responsibilities within the Commission, including the coordination of other aspects of the EU's external action. The EEAS works in close cooperation with the EU Member States, the General Secretariat of the Council, the services of the Commission and the Secretariat General of the European Parliament.

The EEAS Headquarters are in Brussels. It is also responsible for the management of the network of 145 Union Delegations - 9 of which are to international organisations - and Offices worldwide. In all, around 6.000 staff are currently serving in these Union Delegations. These Diplomatic Representations play a vital role in representing the EU in the country where they are based, in promoting the values and interests of the EU, and in building networks and partnerships. They are responsible for all policy areas of the relationship between the EU and the host country/organization.

WE LOOK FOR

Candidates to fill posts at the EU Delegations as per the list in ANNEX 1.

WE PROPOSE

Under the responsibility of the Head of Delegation, and/or the Head of Political/Political, Press and Information (PPI) Section, the selected candidates will assist the Head of Delegation and/or Head of Political/PPI Section in fulfilling their mandate and will have, in particular, the following tasks among others:

1. To contribute to the work of the Delegation and to represent the Head of Delegation when necessary;
2. To pursue the EU's policies in all areas, promote and protect the EU's interests and values;
3. To support and promote bilateral political relations;
4. To promote the visibility of the European Union;
5. To monitor, analyse, and report regularly to Headquarters on internal and regional political developments, foreign policy and/or other policy areas of relevance for EU interests;
6. To ensure local coordination with Member States in the implementation of EU policies;
7. To maintain relations with regional and/or international organisations;
8. To liaise with local civil society organisations.
9. In addition, for Head of Political/PPI Sections: to carry out press, information and communication activities and to manage the Press and Information budget in liaison with the Administration Section;
10. In addition, for Head of Section posts: to manage the work of the Section and ensure that the priorities and objectives set by the Head of Delegation are fulfilled;

11. In addition, for Political and Administration Officers: to ensure the administrative management of the Delegation, with support from Headquarters and from a neighbouring or Reinforced Delegation; this will include, as relevant, to ensure the management of the imprest of accounts, of local procurement, of local staff members, of physical and financial assets and of security, as well as the management of information and EU Classified Information;
12. To provide support to missions from EU institutions.

Multilateral Delegations have the following tasks in addition to the above:

13. To represent the EU in International Organisations.

SELECTION CRITERIA

For general and specific eligibility criteria, posting policy, conditions of recruitment and employment and application and selection procedure, candidates shall refer to the EEAS Rotation Decision¹ and to the annex *Guidelines for the 2027 Rotation Exercise of AD Posts in EU Delegations - External Publication*.

Main criteria by function for all posts

Candidates **should have:**

- a proven ability to maintain diplomatic relations and to ensure representation, communication in a complex, multicultural environment;
- a proven capacity to co-ordinate relevant committee and working group meetings with national authorities, international organisations and EU Member States;
- experience and knowledge of the external relations, internal policies, functioning of the Union and of CFSP and CSDP-related issues;
- strong drafting, communication and analytical skills combined with sound judgement;
- capacity to work in languages of CFSP (EN/FR);
- experience in budgetary and financial management (for Head of PPI Section posts);
- experience in international negotiations (for Head of Political and PPI Section posts);
- experience with relevant administrative (including human resources management), financial and security processes (for Political and Administration Officer posts).

Furthermore, the following would be assets:

- experience in working in an Embassy, a Delegation, an international organisation or significant experience of external relations in the field, including CSDP field missions;
- experience in thematic/horizontal areas of relevance to the Delegation and/or experience on external aspects of internal policies of particular importance in the host country;
- experience in leading and motivating teams (for Head of Section posts).
- experience of working in multi-disciplinary and multi-cultural environment
- good knowledge of the country/region;
- knowledge of locally spoken languages.
