What is Model ASEM?

- Model ASEM is a simulation of an intergovernmental summit inspired by the <u>Asia-Europe Meeting</u> (ASEM), one week before the 51 Heads of States and Governments gather at the 10th ASEM Summit in Milan, Italy.
- It is your unique opportunity to connect and build friendships with 150 fellow university students from 49 ASEM countries.
- You can negotiate with fellow students, building up consensus for a summit declaration on ASEM related issues such as sustainable growth, security and public health.

Why should I participate?

- To engage in political debate and connect with students from 49 countries in Asia and Europe
- To let your voice be heard by proposing concrete actions in the final Model ASEM Declaration
- To share your vision about Asia-Europe collaboration
- To increase your skills in public speaking, communications, team-building and problem-solving
- To acquire an invaluable set of skills for making a positive impact on your community and country

Am I eligible to apply?

If you are:

- a citizen of any of the 49 ASEM member countries
- currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student
- between 18 and 30 years old
- fluent in English (verbal and written)
- ready for home-based Model ASEM preparations starting in September 2014

How can I apply?

- The deadline is **31 July 2014.**
- The organising team will select participants based on their expertise and ensure a geographical and gender balance.

What are the costs for participation?

- There is no participation fee for the participants selected.
- The organisers will cover the accommodation costs and give a subsidy for transportation to participants not based in Italy. Meals will be provided during the programme.
