Tasks and responsibilities related to this post/position:

- Managing the entire service implementation and delivery cycle for regular imagery analysis services (Reference Mapping, Coastal Monitoring and Pre-Frontier Monitoring) as well as for evolution services (Large Area Pre-Frontier Monitoring, Earth Observation Recon, Multi-sensor Monitoring, Permeability Studies);
- Assessment, coordination and prioritizing of Earth Observation requests from both internal and external stakeholders;
- Supporting the definition and implementation of new Earth Observation services under the Copernicus frameworks;
- Coordination, evaluation and further development of Earth Observation training courses in close cooperation with the services and training provider (EU SatCen);
- Drafting and maintaining monitoring and evolution services documentation (guidelines, catalogues and workflows);
- Defining, coordinating and providing reports on the implementation and delivery of EU SatCen services;
- Effective communication and interaction with all relevant stakeholders

Professional qualifications, competencies and experience required:
