**Subject: Call for cost-free Seconded National Expert (SNE) for Frontex Task Force “Deployment Management”**

Dear Sir/Madam,

I have the pleasure to inform you, as part of the “EBCG 2.0<sup>1</sup>” implementation, that a new Task Force called “Deployment Management” has been set up at Frontex with the objective to ensure that the Standing Corps will be fully deployable and able to implement the assigned tasks as of 1 January 2021.

As an opportunity to contribute to this critical mission, I would be pleased that you encourage interested colleagues that could be seconded to Frontex to express their interests by **30 March 2020**.

Based on the rules of secondment defined in the enclosed “Management Board Decision 12/2017 of 30 March 2017”, the period of secondment in Warsaw, Poland would be typically 3-6 months with a possibility for extension, under cost-free modality.

The desired profile, activities to contribute to, conditions for applications, selection process and other useful information can be found in the enclosed Annexes.

Finally, I would kindly remind you to inform the SNE’s employer about the obligations towards the person throughout the period of secondment in accordance with article 1(1) of the SNE rules.
