

Meeting held at NATO Headquarters, Brussels, 15th November,

DECISION SHEET

I. PROGRESS OF THE SECOND STAGE

The COMMITTEE:

- agreed that, for the purpose of analysing the results obtained and the prospects offered by the work of the Economic Committee of the CSCE, a meeting would be held with national experts responsible in Geneva for these questions;
- noted that this meeting should be held while the Conference was in recess, i.e. at the end of the current year, and agreed to schedule it provisionally for Monday, 7th and Tuesday, 8th January, 1974 (subject to confirmation).

II. PROGRAMME OF WORK AND FUTURE ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMITTEE

After a preliminary exchange of views on the general lines of its work for 1974,

The COMMITTEE:

- (1)noted that:
 - early in 1974 the United States Delegation would be preparing a background document on agriculture in the Soviet Union and the Eastern countries;

- (b) the United Kingdom Delegation had agreed to deal with the question of integration within COMECON; a document would be issued in April 1974, or thereabouts;
- (c) the Economic Directorate would be drawing up a document on the balance of payments of the Soviet Union;
- (d) the United Kingdom and the United States would look into the possibility of making a contribution to the study on the influence of the use of computers on economic planning methods in the Soviet Union and the Eastern countries;
- (2) noted the interest expressed by the United States Representative in a study of the economic aspects of the standardization and joint production of weapons;
- (3) agreed to keep this item on the Agenda for the next meeting.

III. APPROVAL OF THE REPORT ON THE ECONOMY OF HUNGARY
