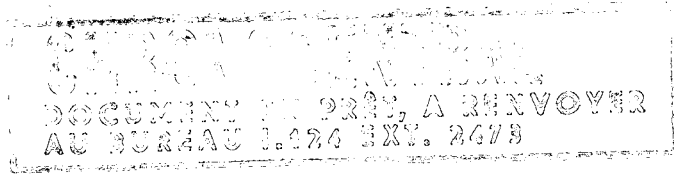

DRAFT DISPLAY OF DATA ON WARSAW PACT GROUND FORCES AS AT MID 1972

Note by the Chairman of the Sub-Group on Data Support

Reference: (a) AC/276-WP(72)36(Revised), dated 27th September, 1972

The standard formats for the display of NATO and Warsaw Pact ground forces data for MBFR (reference (a)) were approved by the Working Group in September 1972. At that time, required data on all Warsaw Pact countries as at end 1971 was available whereas data on NATO countries was incomplete. Consequently, the Sub-Group on Data Support (SGDS) undertook as a first step, to complete the formats for the display of Warsaw Pact ground forces data.

2. A first draft display of Warsaw Pact ground forces as at end of 1971(1) was completed in October 1972. As there was some disagreement within the Sub-Group concerning certain figures shown in this draft, and since all members of SGDS agreed with data included in the latest print-out for Warsaw Pact ground forces as at mid-1972, the Sub-Group decided to discard the end 1971 display and replace it with the updated version.

3. A draft display of data on Warsaw Pact ground forces as at mid-1972 is attached. As will be seen, data on Warsaw Pact ground forces is contained in Part 3 of the Working Paper to be titled "NATO and Warsaw Pact Ground Forces Data for MBFR". Part 2 will contain data on NATO ground forces and Part 1 will provide general information on the subject matter.

4. It is requested that the MBFR Working Group approve the attached draft display on Warsaw Pact ground forces.

5. This paper may not be downgraded without permission of the originator.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. References. The data appearing in Part 3 was extracted from information contained in following documents:

- (a) MC 161/72(Final), dated 6th June, 1972.
- (b) Warsaw Pact Land Forces, Total Listing, RFC(WG)WP(70)2, Annex 3, Revised 1972, dated 20th December, 1972.
- (c) IMSM-71-70, dated 3rd March, 1970.

2. Data Formats:

- (a) The Main format provides total figures of personnel and equipment at all Major HQs, Major Combat Units, Combat Support Units and Service Support Formations under WP Command, as well as for forces remaining under National Command.
- (b) Annex A to Main Format provides detailed information on Major Combat Units.
- (c) Annex B to Main Format gives a breakdown of each country's Combat Support Units by functional type.
- (d) Annex C to Main Format will provide data concerning reserve stocks of equipment (this Annex has not been included due to lack of agreed NATO data).

3. Soviet and Non-Soviets Force Strengths. Actual strengths of ground force personnel in the Soviet and the non-Soviet WP countries are estimated to be:

4. Equipment.

- (a) Tanks. The Soviets are estimated to have 12,000 T-62 MBTs in their line divisions. Production of T-55 tanks continues in Czechoslovakia and Poland, and is being introduced into Motor Rifle Divisions.
- (b) APCs. Tank divisions normally contain the old tracked APC BTR-50. Motorized rifle divisions (MRD), till recently had wheeled APCs of which but half were amphibious. MRDs are now being issued tracked BMP APCs.
- (c) Artillery:
 - (i) Fronts and Armies currently contain the 152 mm gun HOW and the 130 mm field gun M-46.
 - (ii) Divisions mainly contain the 122 mm HOW. At least 50% of Soviet divisions are estimated to have replaced their older equipment with the truck mounted BM-21 multiple rocket launcher and the 100 mm T-12 Anti-tank gun. SAGGER is now the standard anti-tank guided missile.
- (d) Air Defence. The Groups of Soviet Forces have about 40 SA-2 (GUIDELINE) battalions. An SA-2 Regiment (normally three battalions) is deployed with each of the groups of Soviet forces in Poland, Hungary and Czechoslovakia. In East Germany there are 10 SA-2 Regiments. The Soviets rely heavily on light anti-aircraft artillery for air defence of ground forces.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

6. General. A number of explanatory notes are included in the following paragraphs for the convenience of the user.

7. Availability Times. To differentiate the state of availability between that of NATO forces (which includes movement time) and that of WP forces (which excludes movement time), the following identifying symbols have been used:

- (a) NATO forces - M+ days; and
- (b) WP forces - M(WP) + days

8. Personnel. Figures shown for WP forces are based on NATO agreed TO&E tables.

9. AIFVs, Light Tanks, Recce Vehicles. Figures given include only such vehicles carrying a turret/top mounted gun of 20 mm calibre or over.

10. Anti-Tank Guided Missiles. These are counted by launching system. Hand held weapons are excluded.

11. Nuclear Capability. Nuclear weapons in a variety of types and yields are stockpiled and available for delivery by tactical rockets, missiles, guns and aircraft. Notwithstanding this fact, since there is no agreed NATO intelligence on the tube artillery nuclear capability of Soviet forces, nil information has been included in attached formats under column headed "Nuclear Capability".

12. Air Defence Guns. Only radar-controlled guns have been shown.

13. Surface-to-Air Missiles (SAMs). These include Medium as well as High Altitude Interception Missiles. Figures show number of launching systems.

14. Rockets. Those shown are the Force Rocket Over Ground (FROG).

15. Surface-to-Surface (SSMs). The general support tactical ballistic missile for WP forces is the SCUD (SS-1).

16. River Crossing Systems. These include: Bridge Laying Tank (MTU/T34 and T54), TMM Bridge; Ponton TPP, TMP and PMP and GS Heavy Amphibious Ferry.
