Corrigendum to summary record of meeting of the
Council held on 9th September, 1970 - C-R(70)45
dated 23rd September

Page 9, paragraph 22

Delete the existing paragraph and insert the following:

"The DANISH REPRESENTATIVE confirmed his Government's willingness to support the Canadian draft Resolution for a review of the General Assembly's procedures and the establishment of a Committee of Wise Men. Denmark might even be willing to co-sponsor the resolution on condition that there was an adequate number of other sponsors and the geographical balance was not adversely affected. As for the registration of conventional weapons transfers, this was a question in which Denmark had taken an active interest in recent years. The considerations in Copenhagen were still at a preliminary stage, however, and the final outcome could not be predicted. In conclusion, he asked the United Kingdom and United States Representatives for their views on the proposal by the Soviet Union, Syria and Bulgaria regarding the breadth of the territorial sea."

Corrigendum 2 to the summary record of a meeting
of the Council held on 9th September, 1970 -
C-R(70)45 dated 23rd September

Paragraph 30

5th sentence, replace by the following:

"It hoped that the General Assembly would be willing to renew the mandate of the Committee of 33 on the problems of peace-keeping and that the latter would find itself able to play a more active part than it had done in recent years."

7th sentence, replace "United Nations agencies" by "United Nations bodies".

Paragraph 31

Replace by the following:

"Drawing attention to the Agenda item on the election of five non-permanent members of the Security Council, he pointed out that two of these must be selected from among the Western countries and that, of the three candidates for these seats, Italy and Belgium seemed to have considerable backing in the Western group. Speaking on behalf of his Government, he thanked the Allied countries which had already promised their support and hoped that a solution could be found which would enable the group of Western countries to put forward only two candidates for the two seats to which it was entitled."

Paragraph 32

1st sentence, replace by the following:

"In his view, the problems of disarmament could be the most important issues to be dealt with at this session."

Paragraph 33

1st sentence, delete the words "which would be submitted as a alternative to the Soviet proposal."

2nd sentence, insert the word "definite" after "He had no..."

Paragraph 35

3rd sentence, replace by the following:

"As regards the proposal by the Soviet Union, Bulgaria and Syria on the breadth of the territorial sea, he recalled that following a Soviet move, a United States-Soviet draft had been tabled in 1968. During consultations in the Council, Italy had made various objections to this draft, particularly in connection with the provisions for straits. This matter was of vital importance for Italy's defence, security and economy."

Paragraph 37

1st sentence, replace by the following:

"In conclusion, he expressed concern at the future outlook for the International Labour Organization following the United States decision to cut down its contribution."
