VISA "C" (short term)

(Maximum 90 days in any 6-month period)

If you have a **double or multiple entry Schengen visa**, it is **valid** and **it has been used at least once in the country**, which has issued it, you can enter the Republic of Bulgaria without a Bulgarian visa.

About your passport:

- It should have a **validity**, which expires at least
- 3 months after you leave the Republic of Bulgaria.
- It should have at least 2 empty pages for visa;
- It should be issued within the last 10 years

About your application:

- You can apply not earlier than 3 months before the date of your planned departure;
- Applications for children and persons below 18-years of age are submitted from their both parents (or a person with notary verified Power of Attorney);
 - All required fields of the application should be filled;
 - The application should be signed

Documents, required in all cases:

1. Passport (and copy);

2. Copies of the pages of the passport with the personal data and with the issued visas and/or residence permits;

3. Color photo (recent, passport format);

4. Documents, justifying the visa request, as well as copies of these documents;

5. Evidence (for example - a bank statement) of the possession of the necessary financial means for subsistence (at least 50 euros per day /or equivalent/) for each day of the stay, but not less than 500 euros /or equivalent/, OR a document for prepaid tourist services;

6. Evidence (for example – a bank statement) of the possession of the necessary financial means to ensure accommodation, but not less than 50 euros (or equivalent) for each day of the stay, <u>OR</u> a document for prepaid overnights in a tourist facility (hotel, hostel, etc.), <u>OR</u> an invitation-declaration from a Bulgarian citizen or legal entity (with which they declare that they will cover all expenses of the invited person for the period of stay in the Republic of Bulgaria). The invitation-declaration should be on a standard form, issued through the "Migration Directorate" of the Bulgarian Ministry of Interior and it should be notary verified. The original should be presented;

7. Plane or bus ticket for leaving the Republic of Bulgaria;

8. Insurance policy (and copy), issued by an Insurance Company with a license to carry out insurance activities on the territory of the European Union, with a minimum amount of coverage of 30,000 euros. The policy should cover all repatriation costs as well as emergency medical care and emergency hospital treatment for the period of stay.

Documents, justifying the purpose of travel:

Private visit: Invitation-declaration for a foreigner's private visit to the Republic of Bulgaria

Business trip: Invitation-declaration for a foreigner's business trip to the Republic of Bulgaria

Cultural exchange: Invitation letter from the Ministry of Culture or the Mayor of the relevant municipality

Sports: Letter of invitation from the Ministry of Youth and Sports of the Republic of Bulgaria or from a relevant Sports club/ Federation;

Medical treatment: Certificate from a medical institution, issued in accordance with the relevant order, with a specified plan for treatment and recovery; epicrisis from a local hospital.

TOURISM:

Unorganized tourism:

1. Reservation from a Bulgarian hotel;

2.) Two-way plane ticket or reservation /when submitting the visa application, the reservation can be presented, and when the visa is issued - the ticket itself or evidence of owning funds for return.

Organized tourism:

1. Tourist voucher of the sending tour operator;

2. General list of tourists in the group.

3. Documents of organized tourists can only be submitted by accredited tour operators.
